

Since 1927, the fundamental idea of our training has been interdisciplinary work and the fusion of the arts. Folkwang offers you some 40 study courses and programmes, including the

internationally recognised Bachelor and Master degree and Artist Diploma. In addition to special forms of study such as the Junior Study Course and guest student programmes, you can also take doctoral and postdoctoral programmes as well as participate in further courses.

LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

The language of instruction at all Folkwang faculties is German. Therefore applicants have to provide evidence of the necessary language skills for their study course as an admissions requirement or already when applying. APPLICATION

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To take part in the aptitude test for a place in a study course, you apply digitally via the Folkwang application portal in the respective application period and upload all the required documents there. Only in some design study courses a portfolio is also submitted in paper

APTITUDE TEST

The content and procedure of the test varies depending on the study course. The aptitude test can include several stages or take place in one stage. For study courses with multi-stage aptitude tests, the first stage usually takes place in the form of a "digital preliminary round". In this case, a link to the relevant content (e.g. application video) must be added to the portal within the application deadline.
